## Gloria, by Gabriel Fauré, now available from the Chichester Music Press

The Chichester Music Press is now releasing *Gloria*, a setting of the Gloria for liturgical use by Gabriel Fauré. It's been arranged for SATB and organ by Benjamin Costello.

*Vloria* was originally part of *Messe Des* **J**Pêcheurs De Villerville, which Fauré wrote in collaboration with André Messager, and Benjamir which was for ladies' voices. Fauré's Messe Basse, Costello published Chichester also for SATB by the Music Press, grew out of this earlier work, but Fauré had cut his Gloria out of it, as well as all Messager's music, to make Messe Basse into a missa brevis. Messe Basse therefore has no Gloria, and so this arrangement is being published as a companion piece to it, allowing the mass setting to be used in churches where the Gloria is normally sung as part of the liturgy, or as a stand-alone piece.
