A jubilant anthem for SATB, organ and optional timpani, *Love Divine That Floweth From On High* has words by Luke Martens, and was commissioned to celebrate the marriage of the composer's friends Elen and Colin Roberts.

The piece serves as a vibrant and interesting showcase for any choir, and the inclusion of an optional timpani part gives the music an extra dimension which can be exploited on the concert platform.

The first performance was given by the Sirenian Singers at St Collen's Church, Llangollen on 1st November 2008.

Wyn's biography

Wyn appears regularly as a guitarist on S4C, whilst freelancing with other artistes, notably Katherine Jenkins, Michael Ball & legendary rock producer Alan Parsons. He is proud to play with renowned folk singer Siân James.



Original works have been performed by members of the National Orchestra of Wales & the SPNM. He won the Instrumental Ensemble category for Composition at the Welsh National Eisteddfod in 2000 and the coveted Tlws Y Cerddor at the National Eisteddfod in Flintshire in

2007.

He recently completed *Hybrid Picking*, a tuition book and DVD, published worldwide by Mel Bay Publications.
